
- Each Primary 1 pupil will be paired with at least one Primary 4

Preparing Your Child

- Prepare your child mentally by sharing your positive school experience
- Teach your child/ward how to introduce himself/herself
- Things your child/ward should be able to do independently:
 - ✓ Asking for permission
 - ✓ Going to the toilet
 - √ Handwashing
 - ✓ Removing and wearing his/her socks and shoes
 - ✓ Organising school bag
 - ✓ Holding a pencil correctly
 - ✓ Writing his/her name
- Knowledge that your child/ward should have:
 - ✓ Letters of the alphabet
 - ✓ Counting from 1 to 10
- Pre-empt your child/ward about the difference between a pre-school and a primary school
 - ✓ Larger learning environment
 - ✓ Longer school hours
 - ✓ More interaction with pupils and teachers

- Carried out regularly and feedback given through rubrics and pupils' work that focuses on the process of learning



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
School Uniform

- Ensure that your child is given enough pocket money
 - (\$2 should be sufficient)
- Onboard Central Kitchen Meal Model and preorder your child's school meals priced between \$1.80 to \$2.70 from 22 December 2025 onwards.
- Additional food and drinks options are available from WVPS snacks stall and vending machines.



10-minute Break

- 10-minute break is from 11.55 am to 12.05 pm
- Pupils will take the break inside the classroom
- Prepare some simple dry snacks like biscuits, buns, fruit, small packet of milo
